While in Georgia I talked to several negros. At the time there was a heap of talk concerning forcing the negro and whites to attend the same schools together. I asked them what their opinion was, and they all gave me the same answer. "All we want is for them to just leave us alone."

So we can only blame all this trouble on the Government. Just last night on television the negro gave the President hell, and all he said was black rule and we mean to have it.

How sorry I feel for our policemen. They are half paid, and if they try to have order the squawk is brutality. Can we blame them if they all resign?

Uncle Sam would give them hell but I do not believe some of our Parkersburg police would give a damn if they did.

Now the negro can do anything, no law for him. But let the whites try a parade without consent or in my home town they would be arrested, fined or put in jail or both if they desired to do so. Now who do you say is discriminated against.

I have a brother who could sell some lots near town. He has been notified if he fails to sell to a negro he will not be allowed access to the public highway.

Does he have any rights? I would like to work in one more election. But the distance to travel, and not being financially nor physically able it will almost be impossible to do so.

I would like in my most aimable way to be of some help to the Republican nominee of the Republican party of the State of California.
