## Need a Vaccine?

If you have not been vaccinated, mRNA COVID-19 vaccinations, Pfizer BioNTech (for persons aged  $\geq 12$  years) and Moderna (for persons aged  $\geq 18$  years), are available at Minnie Hamilton Health System (MHHS). Please call to schedule a Nurse Visit appointment for the Grantsville Clinic at 304-354-9244 or the Glenville Clinic at 304-462-7322.

## Need a Booster?

As recommended per the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), an additional third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine Pfizer BioNTech (for persons aged  $\geq 12$  years) or Moderna (for persons aged  $\geq 18$  years) can be administered to immunocompromised individuals at the earliest four weeks, at least 28 days, after a second dose. Patients should contact their PCP to determine eligibility and schedule a Nurse Visit appointment.

In accordance with CDC guidelines, MHHS is prepared to offer COVID-19 vaccine booster, third dose, to all Americans (Pfizer BioNTech for persons  $\geq 16$  years) or (Moderna for persons age  $\geq 18$  years) beginning the week of September 20 and starting 8 months after an individual's second dose once we receive authorization to do so. Individuals who were fully vaccinated earliest in the vaccination rollout, including many health care providers, nursing home residents, and other seniors, will likely be eligible for a booster. These guidelines are subject to change and MHHS will keep our community and patients advised.
